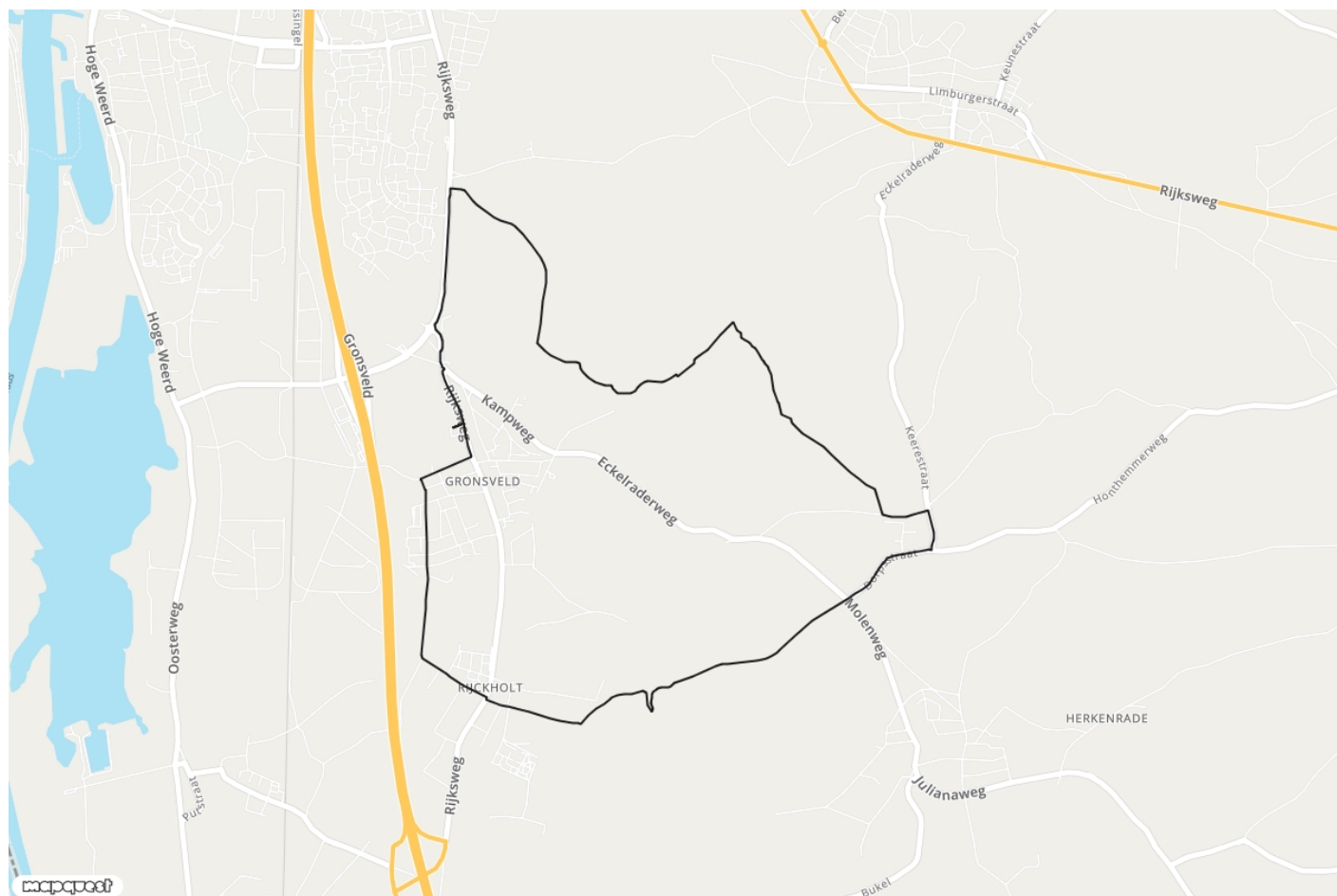

The name Bronkroute comes from the term Bronkfeest: the traditional procession festival. These processions are the pinnacle of Limburg's regional culture. The Historic Bronk Route in Gronsvelt follows the traditional route, which was already popular in 1800. This 'Groete Broonk' took place once every four years and today you can do it all over again and follow the nostalgic walking route along the mill, castle Rijckholt and the village of Eckelrade. The idyllic Savelsbos connects these real Limburg locations. Special Bronk shields indicate the route.
