For more than two hundred years, the traditional procession – or bronk – has been one of the cultural highlights of Voeren in Belgium.

The monstrance, a special relic as a holder for the consecrated host, shows the way on this route, but if you want this route walking, then you can of course just follow the silver shields.

These shields are marked on both posts and the sidewalk. This historic walking route takes you not only through Voeren, but also in the idyllic border towns in the Netherlands: Mesch, Mheer and Noorbeek.
