

Lambert, Count d'Ansembourg, was a diplomat who died unexpectedly in 2007 and the Count of Amstenrade Castle. He gave his name to the Graaf Lambertroute. On this somewhat longer, but easily accessible walking route you will see his castle, but also the avenues and villages that are characteristic of Limburg rural life. You see the meadows and fields, the cool stream valleys and the panoramic views. Along the way you can enjoy a cup of coffee in Oirsbeek or Merkelbeek. In Merkelbeek it is also possible to take the abbreviation back to Amstenrade Castle, where your car will be waiting for you. You follow this walking route via the white (ring) posts.
