Border route Gr6 gives you a spectacular view over the Selzerbeek valley and shows you the pleasant center of Vaals. This walking route leads you via the special red Border Route signs, on which the route number is stated, over the most beautiful paths on the borders that we share with Germany and Belgium. You can park at the Drielandenpunt, which is also the best place to drink coffee. While you're there, try the adventurous labyrinth.
