Vijlen is the highest village in the Netherlands, which is the only village to call itself a mountain village. The town is also the starting point of this very easy walking route with a distance of approximately 6.5 kilometers. You will cross the Harleserbeek, which originates at the foot of the Vijlenerbos. This forest is the largest in the Netherlands and it is known for its unique hiking opportunities. You end at the forest café Het Hijgend Hert, the only mountain hut in the Netherlands. There are sufficient parking facilities in Vijlen (on Pastorijweg) or in the Vijlenerbos (on Epenerbaan). The route can be followed via the white posts.
