The Schutterspark is the oldest public park in Limburg and is located in Brunssum. The existing park was enlarged, renovated and presented to the population in 1952 on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the State Mines.

The park is located in the valley of the Rode Beek and borders the colony (miner's quarter) Schuttersveld, which was formerly built for the Brunssum miners. You will find some nice walking routes, supplemented with catering and surprising (children's) attractions.
