In the village of Bocholtz, the Roman past is still very much alive. The baker bakes Roman bread, the farmer plows over the Roman villa remains and the bank preserves the monetary heritage of the Romans. While walking, take a break in an old-fashioned cozy village pub, taste the Roman bread or enjoy an Italian ice cream. Even in Roman times people lived and worked in and around what is now Bocholtz. Mainly on the fields from the Roman farms, such as Villa Vlengendaal. Not much has changed in that regard, because the remains of the villa are still agricultural land.

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
