The outskirts of Maastricht are a delight for those who love greenery. The walking route with the appropriate green posts takes you through the area of Natuurmonumenten, with the Sint-Pietersberg as the famous eye-catcher. This hill is covered with a beautiful hillside forest and with grassland full of flowers and butterflies. The fortress of Sint-Pieter stands proudly on top. You will also see the marl quarry of the ENCI, which not only provides the Limburgers with the versatile marl, but also beautiful views. You start this route at chalet Bergrust, where you can park within walking distance and drink a nice cup of coffee with a beautiful panorama over this unique area.
