The village of Eijsden has a rich history that dates back to the Middle Ages. Eijsden's geographical location, its inhabitants, and time have combined to create the beautiful picture that Eijsden is today. This walk leads you along the most culturally remarkable places in this town where the Maas enters the Netherlands. You start at the Vroenhof and visit the Ursuline Monastery, the Bat and Eijsden Castle. As an extra part of the walk you can also walk from Eijsden to the Spanish fortress Navagne. The route is not signposted, but easy to follow with the downloadable separate PDF.
