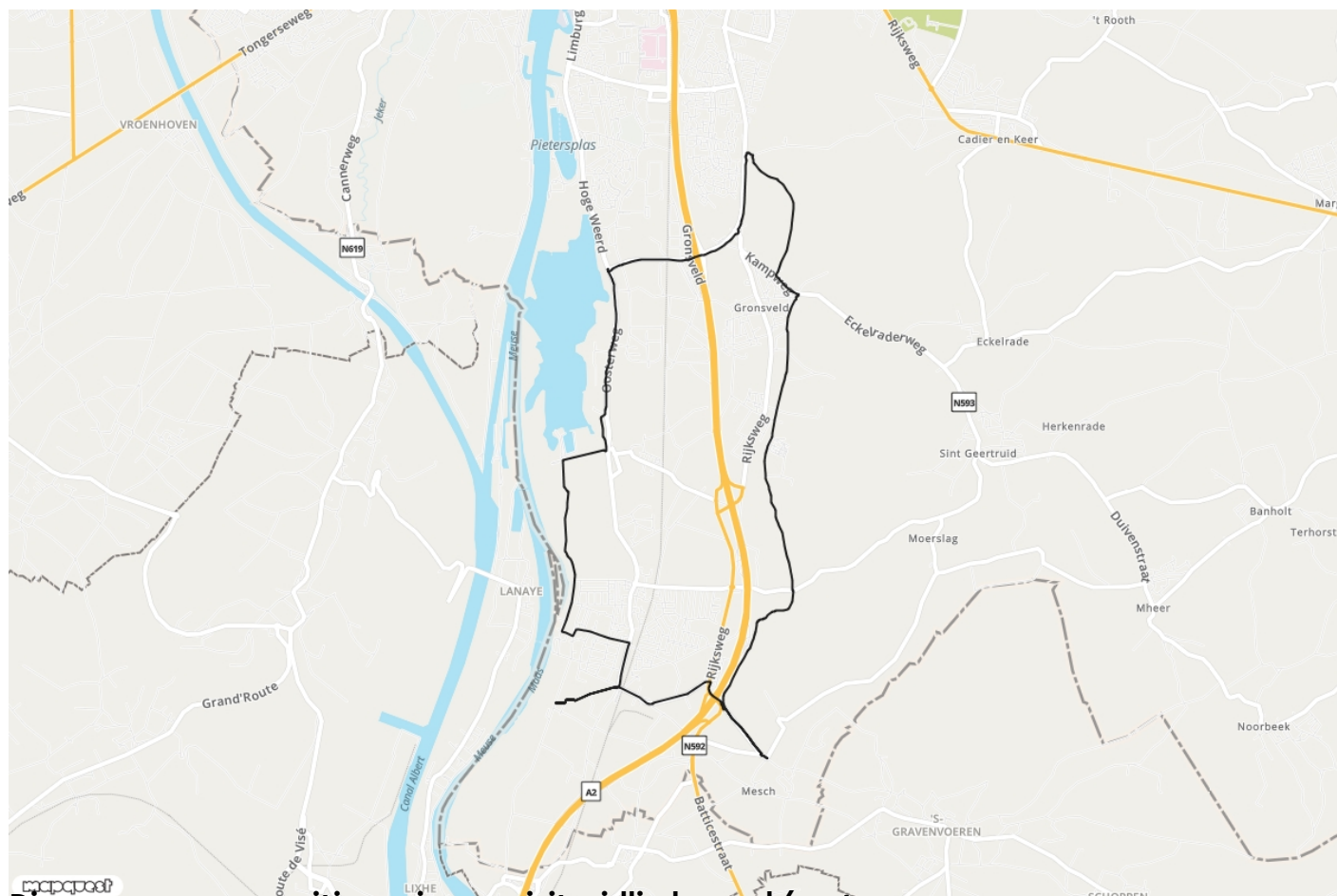

In the Netherlands, the arrival of the liberators was also awaited with bated breath. Because of the approach from the south, American soldiers first set foot on Dutch soil in Eijsden-Margraten. This explains why there is still so much to see and discover here from this turbulent time. So much that you had better take your bike!

The Liberation of the Maas Valley Route is one of the three WWII cycle routes. (Liberation of the Plateau & Liberation of the Heuvelland). The central theme is Cycling to Freedom.
