Walking route

--> 6.3 km

Start- and endpoint

Parkeerplaats in de Doort (kruising Doorderweg-Lange Akkersweg-Bosweg)

Level of difficulty Makkelijk You walk through Meuse beds and channels from a bygone era and you pass earthworks from the early Middle Ages or even older. You will of course also pass the Taterbosch.

The region is rich in lakes with many water birds and is famous in the Netherlands for its tree frog population. All in all, it is a versatile walk in a varied landscape.

This walking route with directions largely follows the municipal network of knots, but is marked differently in a number of places with its own route arrows with the tree frog and the letter T. The route is often unpaved and narrow, which makes it more difficult to walk after a wet period.
