### **Level of difficulty**

Makkelijk

Of course Valkenburg is beautiful, but the nearby Houthem is not inferior to it. When you take the walking route via the black posts, you will see the noble Château St. Gerlach, the tunnel system of the Geulhemmer quarry and the St. Ronald McDonald Kindervallei, the most playful building in South Limburg, designed by the famous Viennese architect Hundertwasser. To guarantee the peace and quiet, we ask that you do not enter the site itself – from the outside you already have a good view of this large, striking building. You will have your walking break at the Geulhemermolen, on the banks of the Geul near the large water wheel.
