



# 7 Summits Wilhelminaberg-wandelroute

 **Walking route**  
→ **5.3 km**

## Start- and endpoint

Parkeerplaats  
Strijthagermolen

## Level of difficulty

Heel moeilijk

This route is part of the 7 Summits, the seven steepest mountain peaks in South Limburg. It concerns a circular walk of 5.5 kilometers with a maximum height of 225 meters.

The Wilhelminaberg is an artificial hill in the municipality of Landgraaf. The hill originated as a slag heap of the Wilhelmina State Mine and was transformed into a recreational area in the 1970s.

From the top, on a clear day, you can see the Claus power station at Roermond, the slag heaps at Genk in Belgium, the Halden in Germany and the lignite power station at Würselen.
